

Adult Education Classes

Adult education classes provide adults an opportunity to learn to read, prepare for the GED test of high school equivalency, or learn English as a second language. All classes are free and are offered at various locations. If you are 16 years old or older and not enrolled in public school, you are eligible. **You must take an Assessment Test prior to attending classes.** **BASIC SKILLS/PREPARATION FOR THE GED TEST** teaches basic skills in reading, English, and mathematics and/or prepares you for the GED test of high school equivalency. Individualized instruction is available. Some locations also offer computerized instruction.
